

# The use of European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) in the Republic of Serbia



Persons from the European Union to whom, in accordance with the regulations in their own country, a European Health Insurance Card has been issued, retain the ability to use this card during their temporary stay in the territory of the Republic of Serbia, provided that the Republic of Serbia has signed the appropriate legal document on the use of the card with that particular country.

**The European Health Insurance Card** represents an alternate for Form - "Certificate of entitlement to emergency healthcare during a temporary stay in Serbia."

The Republic of Serbia has, so far, signed eight "Arrangements on the use of the European Health Insurance Card in the territory of the Republic of Serbia", while it is expected that similar arrangements with other countries will be signed in the future.

Holders of a valid European Health Insurance Card are entitled to health care services in the territory of the Republic of Serbia only in health care institutions listed in the Plan of health care institutions network, as well as private health care institutions with which the Republic Fund for Health Insurance concluded an agreement on the provision of health care services.

Holders of EHIC are obliged to adhere to the procedures provided for by the legislation of the Republic of Serbia, i.e. to request Form INO 1 - "Health certificate for foreign policyholders and members of his/her family" from the competent organizational unit of the Republic Fund for Health Insurance.
